Report card season has arrived at PES. Friday, January 27th, report cards for our students will be either a) sent home with your child if they are in Grade 4 or b) available on parent portal if your child is in Grade 5 & 6. As I have previously shared, our school division has moved to having two report cards in a year rather than three that was in previous years.

For parents in Grade 5 & 6, when you go into the parent portal you will need to choose 'Preview Report Card 3' rather than report card 1. With the change to 2 report cards, our digital system has not quite catch up. All students will be walked through how to do this with their teacher in class so they can support and show you at home.

Our Career and Technology Foundation option classes will be changing again soon. In the last two round our Grade 4 students will be able to join into the option classes. Please see this link to look at what options are going to be offered this round. Students will choose their options at school in class. We encourage parents to talk with their kids about the options offered to help them choose ones that suit their interests. Students are not guaranteed to get the option they pick however we do our best to match the students up with one of the three option choices they give. Our new round of options start Feb 13th. For our grade 4 parents, fees for options (\$20) will be added to your accounts in the near future.

We are approaching our halfway mark of the 2022/2023 year; where has the time gone. January flew by faster than ever before. We hope the rest of the year slows down a wee bit, our students are growing too fast.
